THE G3 EXPANSION PROJECT

- Proposed upgrade to approximately 68 miles of the existing Guardian Pipeline, a 263-mile interstate pipeline that connects Illinois and Wisconsin with U.S. natural gas production.
- The project will increase Guardian's capacity by 40%, enabling it to transport an additional 537,000 dekatherms per day of natural gas to supply the Upper Midwest's growing economy and strengthen power grid reliability.
- Generally located in rural farming regions of northern Illinois, southern Wisconsin.
- Includes a new compressor station along the pipeline's route in Wisconsin.
